Hello General Body Members,

On **Tuesday**, **June 30**th, **2020**, the Dartmouth Graduate Student Council (GSC) Executive Board met for its monthly meeting. Below were the points of discussion:

• Topic 1. Block Funding and Reimbursement Policies

- An email to organizations should be going out soon requesting that clubs submit their fiscal year 20-21 budget to us, and the **budget committee** will be formed at the **July General Body meeting.**
- A concern was raised that refunds can be prohibitive for students. While a cash advancement option is
 presented on our website, students may not realize that this is an option. It may be worth looking into what
 other viable options exist for refunds, such as the ability for clubs to have their own debit cards.

• Topic 2. Orientation and Guarini Graduate Student Guide

- For remote orientation this year, a Canvas page will be created that covers the various modules that would be covered in person. These modules will likely be released gradually over the course of multiple weeks, with a concluding panel for individuals to answer questions.
- The Activities Fair will also be remote this year, which will involve an interactive session as well as prerecorded videos for each organization
- o Some kind of **live tour of campu**s shared on social media is also in the development stage.
- To compliment the experience, a student representative from each department will serve as a pointperson for incoming students in their program to ask questions.

• Topic 3. Remote Voting for Sensitive Matters

- Sometimes, there are topics that require a **time-sensitive vote between meetings** that don't necessitate a separate gathering (e.g., signing an external petition).
- o A **bylaw** that will **formalize this process** will be voted on at the next General Body Meeting.

Topic 4. Anonymous Submission Review

- A concern as raised that PIs have not been sensitive to the ongoing public health pandemic and their students' corresponding mental health. The executive board will look into which resources exist to share with faculty.
- A concern was raised about virtual programming to foster the community. The executive board will look into various asynchronous and live events that can help keep students connected during this time.
- A concern was raised about raising children in an anti-racist world. We will be putting together a
 "Podcast of the Month" series that covers sensitive topics in a thoughtful and accessible manner.
- A concern was raised about power dynamics within a lab and reporting mechanisms that are available.
 This concern will be included in the upcoming Executive Board meeting with Deans Kull and Landers on July 23rd, 2020.
- We continue to address previous anonymous submission through the generation of a housing infographic and letter to Guarini (1) as well as an infographic on Phase 2 Research Ramp-up Procedures (2).
