Hello Dartmouth Graduate Students,

On **Tuesday**, **July** 7th, **2020**, the Dartmouth Graduate Student Council (GSC) met for its monthly July General Body Meeting. Below is a summary of the points of discussion:

• Topic 1. Orientation Updates

- Orientation will be completely online this year, with Canvas modules released over the course of
 August and September. Each module will focus on one of several resources available to graduate
 students and include a short video intro. If you are interested in "acting" in the intro, email
 graduate.student.council.activities@dartmouth.edu.
- We are currently putting together a comprehensive Guarini graduate guide for incoming students, complemented by virtual graduate tours of campus
- o The Activities Fair will be online this year and include introductory videos and a Zoom panel.
- Throughout both orientation and the year, a "Virtual Graduate Lounge" will serve as a remote place to bring students together

• Topic 2. Anonymous Submission Form [https://forms.gle/beqdcTf5FHkA6vWV6]

- o For students concerned about **relationships with faculty**, the GSC will **work to share resources with faculty on how to better communicate with and help their students.** The GSC will also work to **propose an ombudsperson** to the administration
- For students concerned about **raising children in an anti-racist world**, the GSC will work to develop a "**Podcast of the Month**" series that will cover **sensitive topics** in a **thoughtful manner**.

• Topic 3. Mount Support Shuttle Schedule and New Graduate Housing

- Michaels shared a tentative shuttle plan for the new graduate housing complex with the General Body in order to receive graduate student feedback.
- Views on the shuttle were generally positive with a few concerns; however, the main concern was the
 cost of rent for the new housing. As a result, a Michaels representative will be invited to the August
 General Body Meeting to discuss (and possibly assuage) concerns

Topic 4. Reflect Educate Act Discuss (READ) Journal Club

- The Student Life Chair is creating a journal club for graduate students that fosters thoughtful conversations on complex subjects such as anti-racism

• Topic 5. Bylaws Discussion

- A bylaw was brought up for discussion surrounding the use of block funding for movie screenings.
 This conversation was tabled until next meeting in order to investigate multi-group licensing options.
- A bylaw was brought up for discussion and passed surrounding remote voting via Slack for timesensitive material in-between monthly meetings.
- A bylaw was brought up for discussion and passed surrounding withdrawal of GSC recognition for graduate student organizations.
