

Discussion:

- 1. Graduate Student Senate
 - a. Geisel student body president, Tuck student body president, Thayer student body president, and GSC president, Katharine von Herrmann, met to discuss updates and possible collaborations with the programs
 - b. Typically, the student senate includes 2-3 representatives from each school, including TDI, and the senate is funded by the provost to host events for all schools to get together
 - c. Next meeting is Thursday 11/1/2018 and we will update the general council at the meeting the following week
- 2. Budget and Monthly Expenditures Reports
 - a. Updates to the reports have been made based on comments from the last general council meeting
 - b. Completed report will be put up for approval again at the general council meeting next week and be posted to the website pending approval by the council
- 3. Task Force on Access to Electronic Information and the Council on Computing
 - a. Current outline proposes to setup a taskforce appointed by the provost to decide when to reveal Dartmouth-associated persons information
 - b. Amendments to this policy would be made by a committee appointed by the provost that would consist of community members affected by the issue in question
 - c. If anyone has questions or comments about the newest draft up for approval by this taskforce reach out to finance chair Daniele Bellutta
 - d. There will also need to be a GSC representative elected as a graduate student representative on the Council of Computing, which is the council that will be approving the final version of this policy
- 4. Student Support Network
 - a. This has been created at Dartmouth and will be hosting one session per term to train graduate students on how to support each other mentally during times of stress and recognize students in need
 - Bryant Ford of the counseling center has offered to host a suicide prevention workshop (~2-hour session) in addition to the training sessions hosted for the support network
- 5. November Meeting Agenda
 - a. Proposed alterations to GSC bylaws: requiring a GSC organization advisor
 - i. All organizations were allowed to get a faculty advisor for those that did not have one and if this is approved at the general council meeting those organizations will no longer be active/ recognized

Updates:

 - a. The council was receptive and open to ideas of how to help graduate students and PIs to produce a better environment
